TO PATIENTS WITH MINOR CHILDREN

In order for children to receive dental care during a parent's absence, Dental Associates of Cedar Rapids requires a "Permission to Treat Minor Children" form. A minor is defined as anyone less than 18 years of age.

State law prohibits medical facilities from treating minor children, except in life threatening situations, without first obtaining permission for the child's parents or legal guardian.

There is space on the form for an expiration date if you wish to use the form for short-term coverage while you are on vacation or otherwise unavailable. If no specific date is included on the form, it is assumed the consent to treat extends to the time the child is 18 years of age. It is necessary to complete a form for each child in the family.

At our 6 month recare appt, we do an exam, prophylaxis, BW x-rays (approx yearly) and fluoride is recommended (some insurance companies pay once per year).

- BW x-rays 1 time/yearly
- No x-rays
- Fluoride every time
- Fluoride 1 time yearly
- No Fluoride
